

# FLOOR CLEAN

CONCENTRATED DETERGENT FOR DEEP CLEANING AND WAX REMOVAL FROM PVC, RUBBER, LINOLEUM AND CERAMIC FLOORS

# **DESCRIPTION AND USES**

PRODUCT FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY

Wax stripping detergent for the removal of old layers of traditional metallic wax and for deep-cleaning floors. When used diluted, FLOOR CLEAN has the added benefit of not foaming, so the floor is not slippery during cleaning.

## **METHOD OF USE**

Prepare a 10% solution of FLOOR CLEAN in water (1 liter of FLOOR CLEAN in 10 liters of warm water) and pour over the floor. Leave to work for approximately 15 minutes (do not allow to dry) and then remove dirt and/ or old wax with a scrubbing brush. Rinse thoroughly. Once dry, treat the floor with FLOOR SHINE.

#### OTHER INFORMATION

Some linoleum floors tend to change color with use of wax stripping detergents; check color fastness in an inconspicuous area, possibly diluting the product more and leaving it to work for a shorter time. Some old and particularly porous floors that are very absorbent require two rinses with water before applying FLOOR SHINE.

#### INSTRUCTIONS
