METHOD OF USE

The floor must be properly vacuumed and degreased using the appropriate product FLOOR CLEAN PRO. If the floor has never been treated with wax, proceed only with washing the surface using the neutral detergent FLOOR CLEAN DAILY.

Apply NOVA CARE evenly, either pure or diluted at 20% with water (200 ml of product per litre of water), onto the floor using a wax applicator or a soft cloth. Allow it to dry thoroughly for at least one hour. Apply a second coat in a crosswise direction to the first application.

OTHER INFORMATION

Subsequent cleaning of the treated floor can be carried out only after a few days. Do not apply NOVA CARE on surfaces with a temperature below 10°C or above 25°C.
